Fall 2018:

- All OMD Fall CE online modules
- In person Lecture Session required for all Credentialed Paramedics

The deadline for Education completion is December 15, 2018. Completed organization rosters are due into the OMD by December 22, 2018. On January 7, 2018, anyone who has not completed their 2018 continuing education requirements will be automatically placed on an OMD Administrative hold for up to 90 days. Accommodations for OJI/FMLA/Military Deployments will be coordinated with the OMD. Refer to Clinical Standard CS-29 for OMD Administrative Hold and OMDR-9 for Credential Maintenance Requirements.

Beginning in calendar year 2019 the System Medical Directors will be implementing significant changes to our initial System Credentialing and maintenance of Credentials processes. They will be reaching out to System Organizations over the next seven (7) months to finalize concepts, develop infrastructure and, begin building a portfolio frame work. The System should be ready by January 2019 to implement the new processes and; begin collecting the required Credentialing data points for each Provider/Responder.
