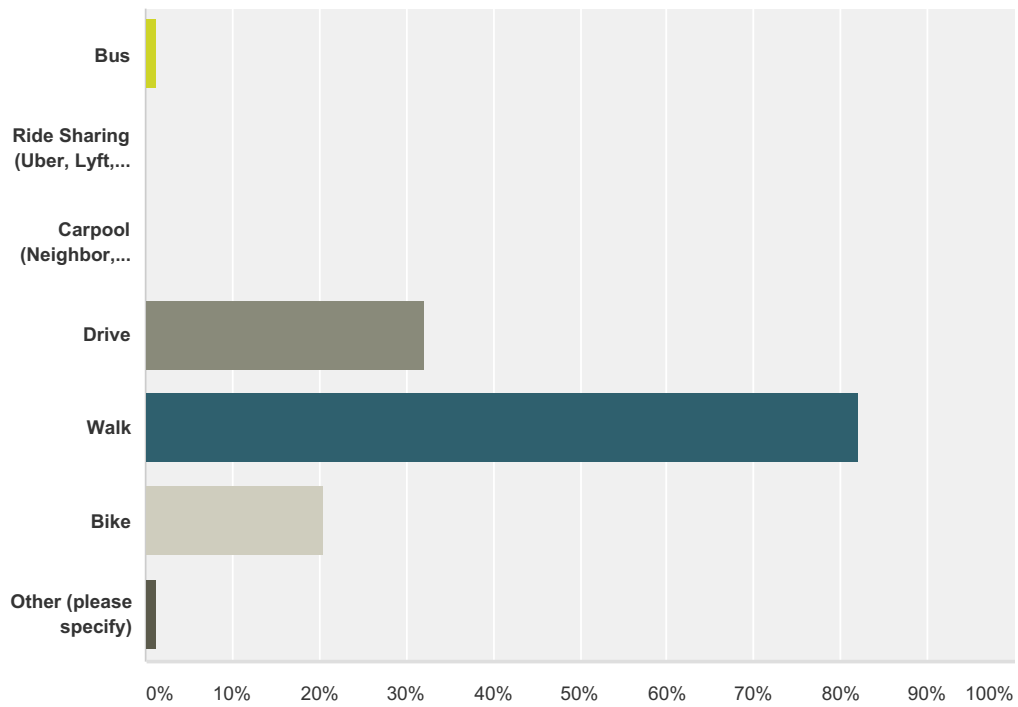

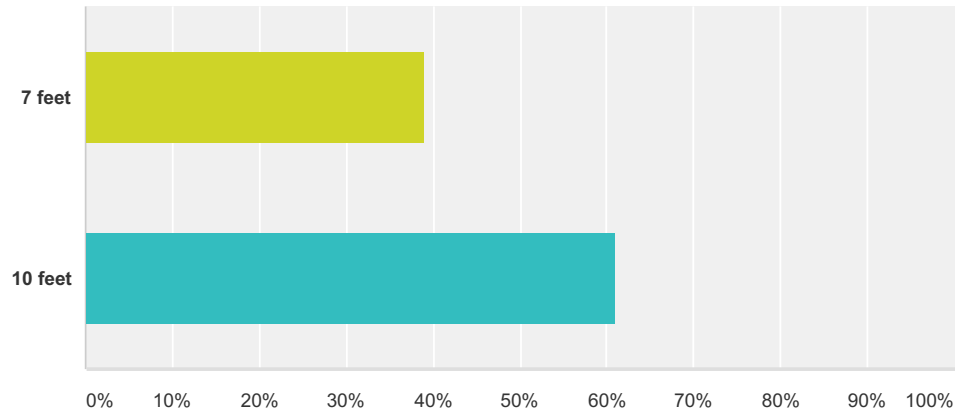

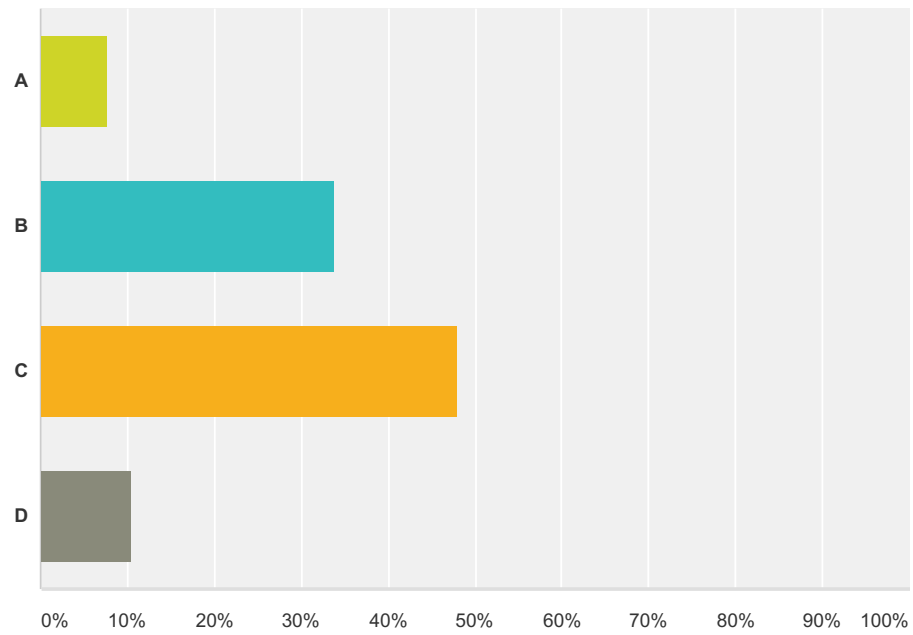

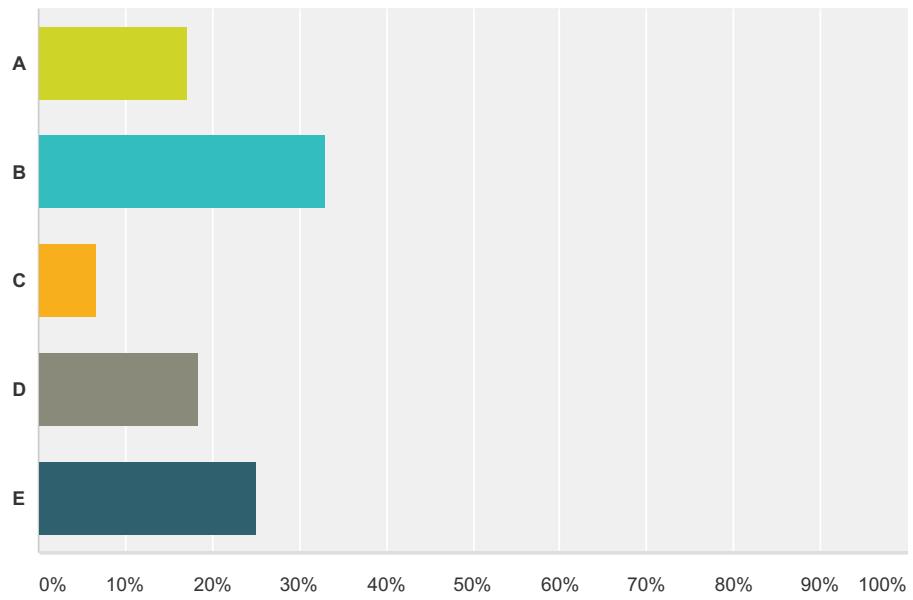

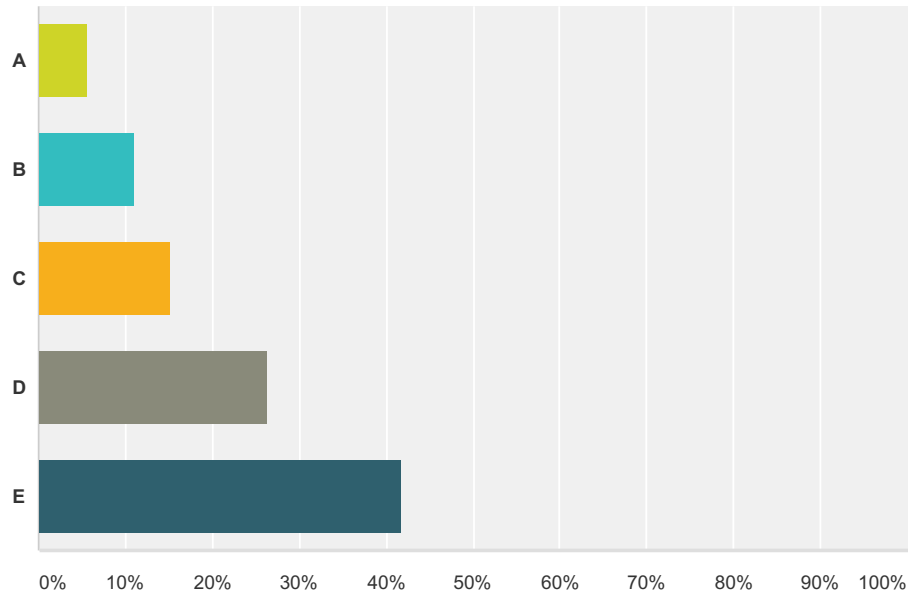

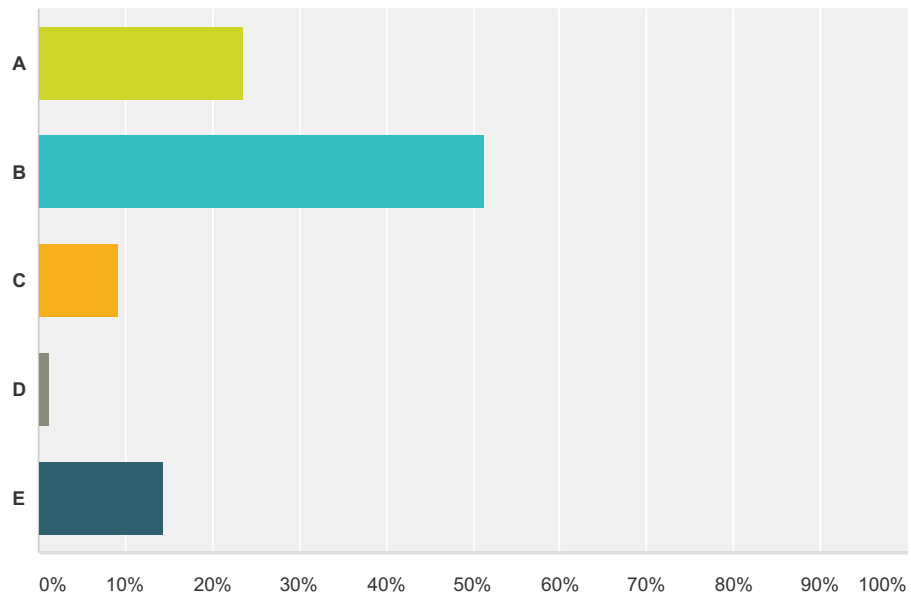

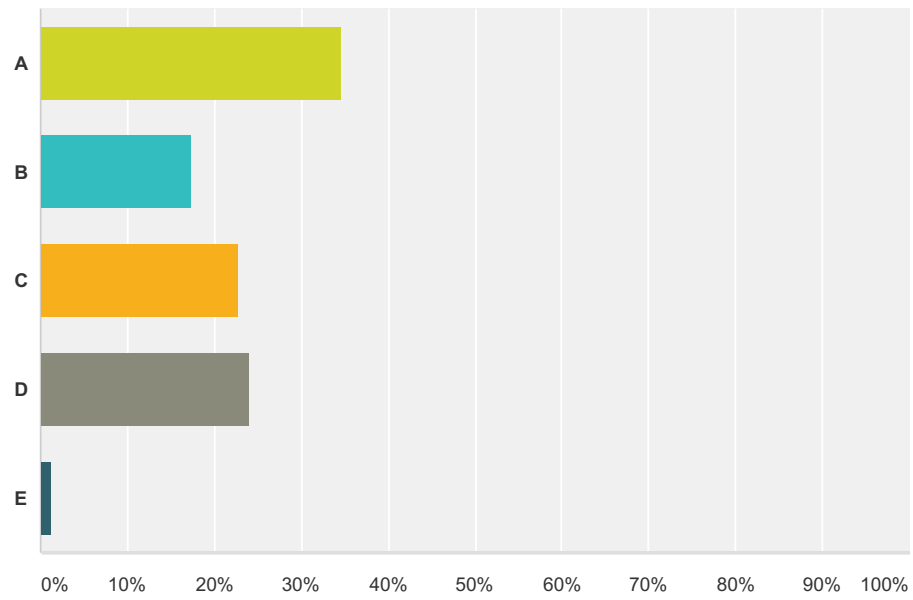

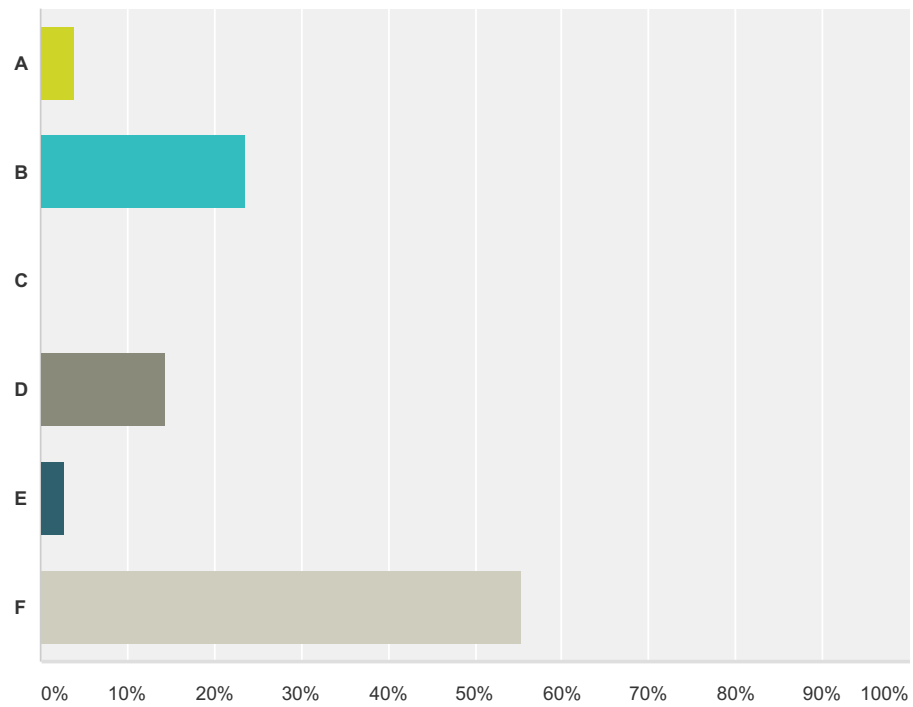

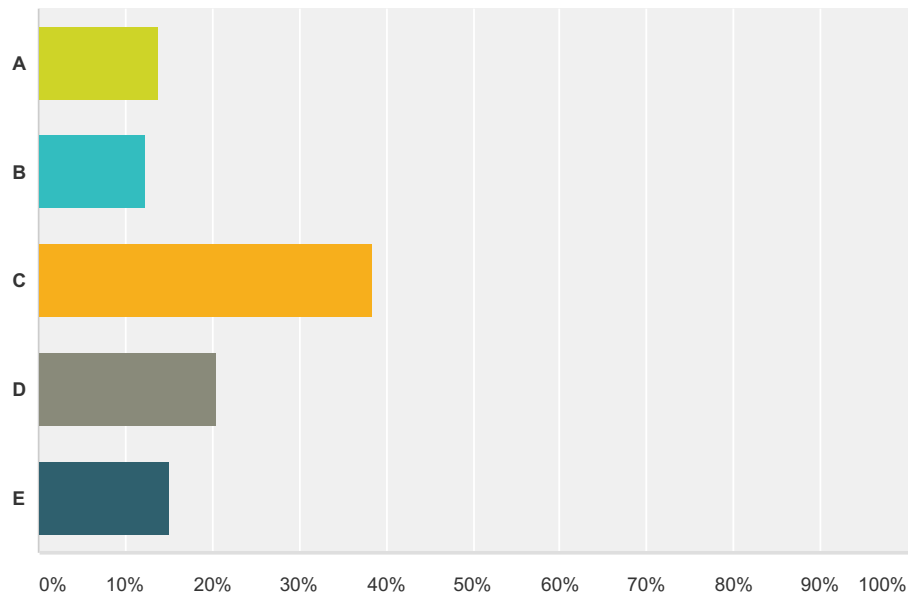

## Q18 Please select your favorite lighting option from the image above.

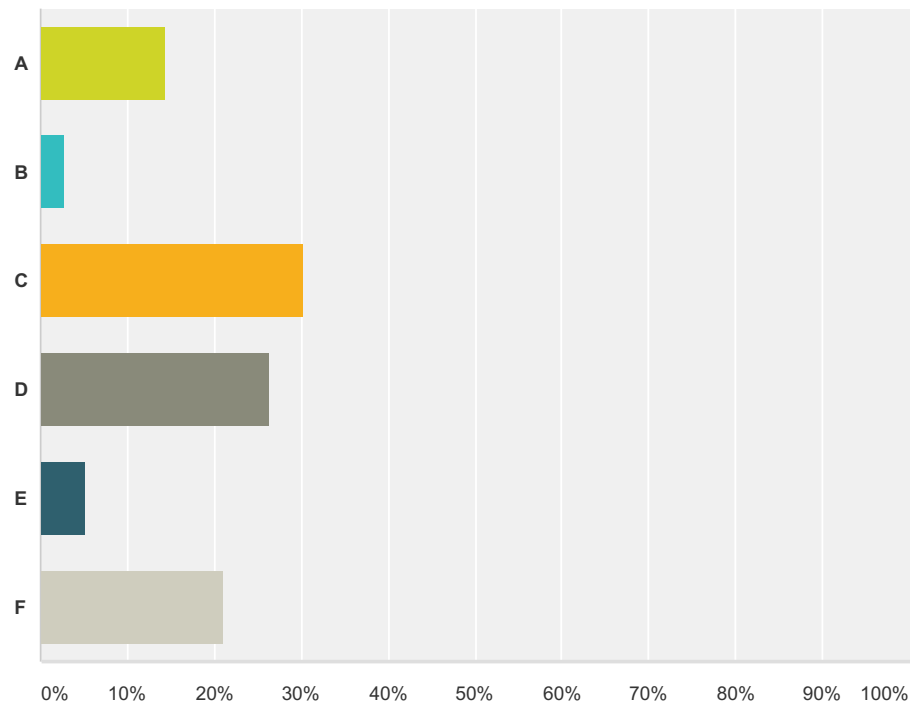

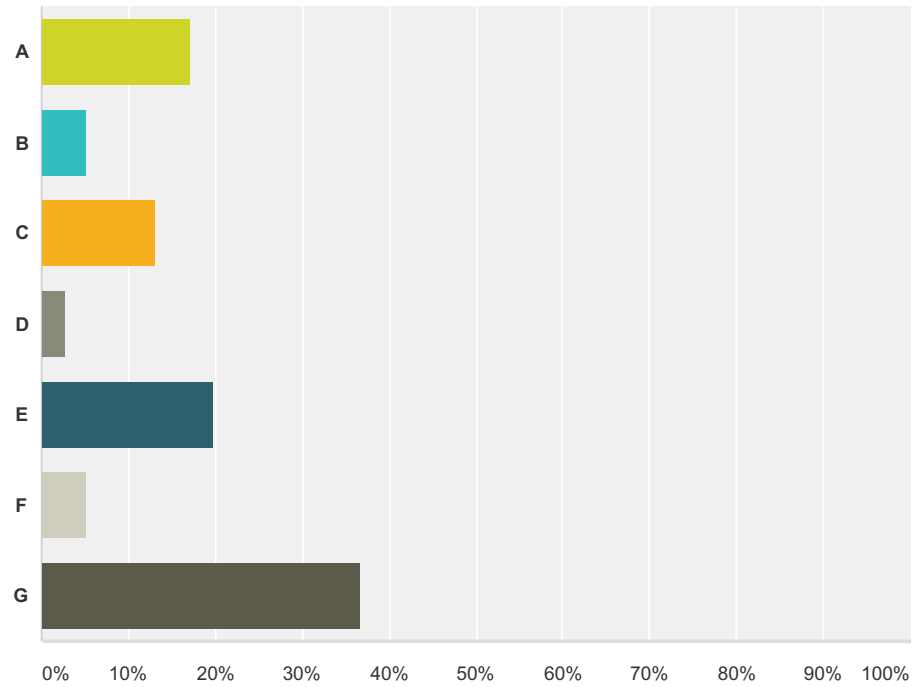

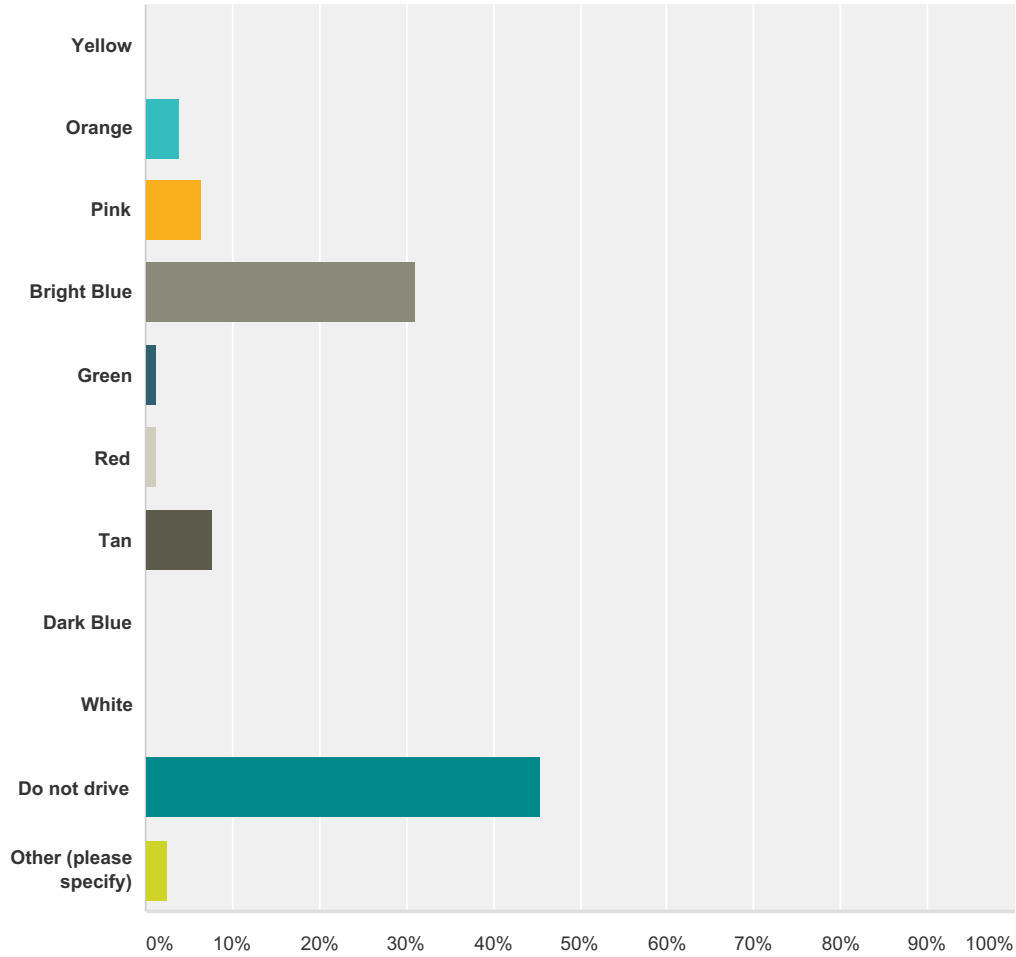
