402.5 REPORTING THE ACTIVE TARGETING OF A FIREARM AT A PERSON

By the nature of their duties, officers may be required by general orders and training to point their firearm, ~~including impact munitions, and actively target at a person.~~ at a person to actively target them.

This section does not create an additional requirement for officers to initiate an incident report; however, officers that actively target their firearm at a person shall properly document the incident as outlined below.

- a) For the purposes of this General Order, TASER Conducted Energy Weapons and less lethal weapons firing kinetic energy projectiles (i.e., less lethal shotguns, 37mm, and 40mm launchers) are not considered firearms.
